## \*\*EXAMPLE OF THE GUIDED IMAGERY & MUSIC METHOD (GIM) A RECEPTIVE FORM OF MUSIC PSYCHOTHERAPY

Guided Imagery & Music (GIM-the Bonny Method) is a receptive form of music-assisted psychotherapy. It is an innovative integrative tool that can be used alongside many therapeutic approaches with scientific evidence for effectiveness in a growing variety of clinical fields.

A 3-day introductory (level I) seminar and workshop will be offered twice in alternative dates (Oct/Nov or Dec) to introduce mental health professionals to basic theory and practice of GIM. A full training in the method will be offered in 2018 for those who wish to continue. The training focuses on the traditional GIM method but also incorporates modifications and adapted shorter forms of Music and Imagery (MI), appropriate for work in various fields such as psychological trauma, psycho-oncology, palliative care, perinatal psychology, addictions, team-building, etc.

The professional training course offered by IMAGEing is accredited by the international Association for Music and Imagery (AMI). Graduates are eligible to apply for registration as Fellows of AMI and approved therapists of the method. The 24 hours of this seminar count towards the total number of training hours in the GIM method.
